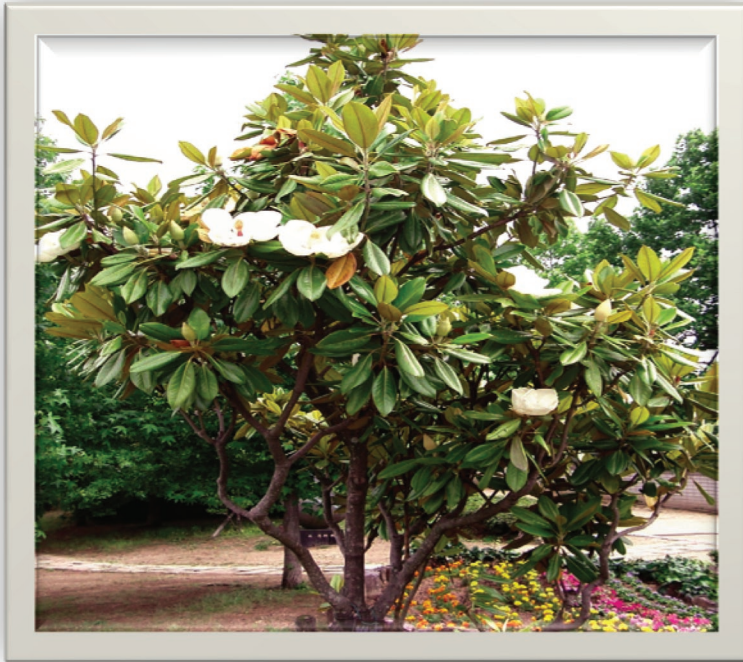

Scientific Name: *Magnolia Grandiflora* 'St. Mary'

Common Name: Magnolia

Size: 20' tall x 20' wide

Deciduous / Evergreen: Evergreen

Leaves / Flowers: Attractive large green glossy leaves. Large white flowers in summer and fall.

Exposure: Full sun or partial shade

Water: Regular water

Origin: Cultivar of the U.S. native Southern Magnolia

Sunset Zones: 4-12, 14-24; H1, H2

Maintenance: Low. Prune to shape and prune girdling roots.

Comments: A smaller version of its much larger parent. Can be planted in lawn areas. Susceptible to Verticillium Wilt, a fungal disease found in some soils.
