Scientific Name: *Pistacia chinensis*

Common Name: Chinese Pistache

Size: 30-50' tall x 30-40' wide

Deciduous / Evergreen: Deciduous

Leaves / Flowers: Foot long leaves with 10-12 narrow leaflets. Leaves turn beautiful orange to red in fall. Insignificant yellowish-green flowers in panicles in spring.

Exposure: Full sun

Water: Little to regular water

Origin: China

Sunset Zones: 4-16, 18-23

Maintenance: Prune when young for branching structure and as needed in the late fall and winter seasons for shape and size.

Comments: Slow to moderate growth rate. In summer, there are small red to purple fruit on female trees.
