CBWCD Board of Director Position Available

Inland Empire (December 05, 2011) – After 14 years of diligently serving on Chino Basin Water Conservation District’s (CBWCD) board of directors, board member John Reddick is retiring to start a new chapter of his life in Temecula, California. The open seat presides over CBWCD’s District 3. The boundaries of this district run approximately from Mountain Avenue to Vineyard Avenue and from the 10 freeway to Holt Avenue (more exact boundaries lines can be found at www.cbwcd.org). In addition to attending monthly meetings, board members serve on various committees including the Education, Facilities, Finance, Personnel, and Recycled Water Committees.

Chino Basin Water Conservation District’s commitment to conservation is two-pronged, consisting of the use percolation basins and spreading grounds to replenish the Chino Ground Water Basin, and the commitment to water conservation education to diminish demand. The use of percolation basins has made the District one of the first agencies in California to take a proactive role in region-wide water conservation. The water conservation education approaches that have been undertaken at the District address individuals, school districts, organizations, and municipalities within its service area.

Kati Parker, Chino Basin Water Conservation District’s Board President explained that, “Serving on CBWCD’s board is more than just being an elected official, because of CBWCD’s obligation to conservation; it is also being an educated, realistic and caring environmentalist.”

Interested candidates should complete an application and send it along with their resume to CBWCD by December 27, 2011. The appointment is only until November 2012, then the seat will be up for election on the 2012 ballot.
