PARKS IN MONTCLAIR CONNECT TO RECYCLED WATER

Montclair, CA – On Monday, July 19, 2010 Chino Basin Water Conservation District presented the City of Montclair with a reimbursement check for \$26,022.42 to help the City offset the retrofitting of irrigation systems and conversion to recycled water for six of the City’s parks: Alma Hoffman Park, Golden Girls Park, Kingsley Park, Saratoga Park, Sunrise Park and Sunset Park.

In 2009, Monte Vista Water District, the city’s water provider, constructed lateral pipelines off of a regional recycled water pipeline in order to bring recycled water to large water use customers for landscape irrigation, such as these parks. The non-potable recycled water distribution system is completely separate from the District’s drinking water distribution system and uses “purple pipes” to distinguish it from the potable system.

By converting these parks to recycled water, the City will be saving \$19,812.44 annually. In addition, 120 acre feet or 39,102,120 million gallons of potable water are now being used for higher and better use. This massive amount of potable water is enough to provide over 150 families of four in the City of Montclair with enough water for an entire year!

CBWCD converted the park adjacent to their facility at 4594 San Bernardino Street in Montclair to recycled water two years ago and are pleased with the water quality and the lower rates.
